

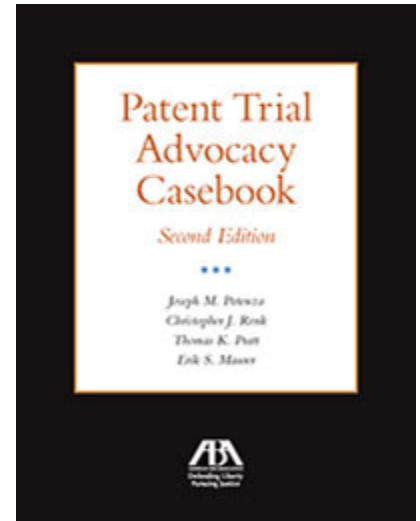
NEW from the American Bar Association – ***PATENT TRIAL ADVOCACY CASEBOOK, SECOND EDITION***
